







Home Use of Hearing Assistance Technology (HAT)

Scenario	Use the HAT?	Who Should Use The Microphone?
<p>Meal Time</p> 	Yes!	Pass the microphone amongst family members to help the child follow the conversation.
<p>Driving In The Car: Child Back Seat</p> 	Yes!	The person in the front seat.
<p>Reading Books</p> 	Yes!	The person reading the book.
<p>Watching TV</p> 	Yes!	Place microphone by the TV speaker or plug in device adapter cable to the headphone jack and transmitter.
<p>Playing With Toys And Games</p> 	Yes!	Whoever is playing with the child. If multiple people are playing together, the microphone should be passed.
<p>Sporting Events</p> 	Yes!	The child's coach or instructor should use the microphone.
