## Our Surgery Team

Our surgical team includes physicians, registered nurses and support staff. We exceed the recommended staffing standards for the care of our patients.

Child-life specialists are on-site and available to help alleviate fears and anxieties a child may experience during hospitalization through medical play, education and coping strategies.

Many children require sedation for procedures. All children will be cared for by a board-certified physician anesthesiologist experienced in sedation and anesthesia for even the smallest of patients. Our anesthesiologists are known for their gentle care and will remain by your patient's side throughout any medical procedure using anesthesia.
